C.A.R.E.'s *Tree of Life* Legacy

When Dr. Hal Ott founded C.A.R.E. in 2001, the mission began to rescue, rehabilitate, and re-home neglected, abused, and unwanted dogs and cats. Our humble beginnings started with a former pet motel located on three acres in Ruskin, FL. A converted garage became our cat facility and an old run down trailer served as an office. In April 2003, we added a low-cost spay/neuter clinic that still serves our community by helping to reduce the overpopulation of unwanted animals. In the Fall of 2007, we constructed a new cat

facility that includes three free roaming cat condos. Most recently, a project was completed that added six small dog runs to our main indoor kennel. Both additions have allowed C.A.R.E. to rescue and adopt more animals in need, than ever before.

Since our inception, we have cared for and adopted approximately 2,000 dogs and cats, many of whom were abandoned on the streets of our community to fend for themselves.

C.A.R.E. is a non-profit organization that receives no government funding. We rely on the generosity of local individuals and businesses to support our operating costs and staff our shelter with volunteers. C.A.R.E. could not exist without this support.

The economic crisis is causing C.A.R.E. to experience new growing pains. Animal abandonment and relinquishment rates are at all time highs. C.A.R.E. is exploring ways to expand the amount of space available for housing dogs and cats, refurbish our medical/surgical suite plus other options that will allow us to continue serving the community when and how it needs us most.

This Tree of Life campaign will not only help us achieve our goals, it also provides the opportunity for you, your company, or civic group to honor a pet or loved one, memorialize someone who has passed on, or leave your own personal legacy.
