# CBD Weeding out the facts

CBD and hemp products for dogs and cats are becoming increasingly more common so it is important to be well informed on them. Here are some things to consider before starting your dog on CBD products.

## What is CBD?

CBD stands for Cannabidiol. It is one of the many chemicals derived from the cannabis plant (also known as marijuana or hemp) and has no psychotropic (hallucinogenic) effects on the brain. Basically, it does not have the ability to cause a high feeling. The "high" of marijuana is actually caused by the molecule THC.

## What does it do?

The actual activity of CBD in the body has not been studied very well. There are several different receptors on cells in the body that show some response to the CBD molecule. These could be related to some of the proposed medical benefits in humans that include: anti-seizure and protective to the brain, anti-inflammatory, pain relieving, anti-anxiety, anti-tumor effects, and treatment of vomiting and inappetence.

## Is it legal?

CBD is only legal in the state of Florida if it is derived from industrial hemp. This is hemp that has been grown specifically to have a very low concentration of THC in it.


## Is it safe?

CBD by itself is considered safe and non-toxic. Many of the concerns lie within the other components of CBD products. For example, human grade CBD can potentially contain xylitol (an artificial sweetener) which can be very toxic to dogs. Additionally, they can contain higher percentages of THC which can also cause toxicity in our furry friends.

## What product is best?

There is no good answer to this question because there are so many products and no clinical trials in dogs and cats. Currently, we recommend making sure it is a veterinary product and that there is a certificate of analysis with whatever product you buy to ensure the THC content is lower than 0.3% and that there are no harmful chemicals for animals. Remember that products you order can come from anywhere and the rules in those states may be different from Florida.

## Making the Most Out of your Dog's Heartworm Prevention

Monthly heartworm preventatives have been available for over thirty years and yet the incidence of heartworm disease is not decreasing. Two main reasons are becoming apparent for this trend: Not all clients are actually given a recommendation for heartworm prevention, and not all clients are compliant with following the recommendations that are given. This article

Compliance is defined as the consistency or accuracy with which someone follows the regimen prescribed by a medical professional. Terms such as adherence, cause, or belief, have also been used to describe this behavior.

will concentrate on the latter factor.

Compliance depends on the acquisition of preventive, owner administration of the product, and ensuring the medication is not vomited or otherwise removed from or by the pet.

Part of the reasons for non-compliance may be linked to studies that have shown 56% of dogs in the heartworm endemic South leave veterinary offices without prevention, and veterinary visits themselves are declining. In 2009 dog owners averaged 11.5 months between veterinary visits, but by 2014 it was 16.9 months. Even in human medicine, compliance for taking medications on a long-term basis is typically only 50 %, dropping to 20 or 30% if a lifestyle change is required.

> For these and other reasons, Pro-Heart 6 is a viable choice to dramatically increase compliance for our

> > pets. An injection, given once every six months, eliminates the need to remember a dose, or to make sure the pet hasn't vomited the product. A new version, Pro-Heart 12, will last twelve months. With choices like this, compliance will be much easier to achieve.

Only with the implementation of new strategies will we be able to decrease the incidence of heartworm disease. We cannot

change human nature, and unless that is factored into how we approach this disease, progress will be slow. Monthly heartworm preventatives have been on the market for 3 decades, and we are seeing instances of resistance to some preventions and decreasing veterinary visits. Perhaps Pro-Heart will be able to reverse the trend and allow us to increase compliance.
